

# How do seasons change in the UK?

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
<b>United Kingdom</b>	The United Kingdom, made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, is an island nation in northwestern Europe.
<b>country</b>	Land that is controlled by a single government.
<b>city</b>	An inhabited place of greater size, population or importance than a town or village.
<b>season</b>	A time in the year (spring, summer, autumn and winter) marked by particular weather patterns and daylight hours.
<b>weather</b>	Weather is what the sky and the air outside are like, such as cold and cloudy.
<b>weather forecast</b>	What the weather is likely to be for the next day or few days.
<b>temperature</b>	The measured amount of heat in a place or in the body.
<b>temperate</b>	Seasonal climate that doesn't have extreme weather events.
<b>island</b>	A piece of land completely surrounded by water.



## Sticky Knowledge about the seasons and the UK.

- There are four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter.
- The weather changes often in the United Kingdom. Different types of weather are more likely to happen in certain seasons.
- The length of the day changes depending on the season.
- The United Kingdom is made up of four countries: England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. The capitals are London, Belfast, Edinburgh and Cardiff.
- The United Kingdom is bordered by four seas: the English Channel, the North Sea, the Irish Sea and the Atlantic Ocean.
- The UK is made up of several islands. The only land border connecting the UK to another country is between Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland.
- The seasons affect trees. Some trees' leaves turn brown and fall (deciduous) whereas others (coniferous) stay green and do not fall.
