General questions about Computing

Children from Early Years have feedback on Computing. Some of the questions asked may have been slightly re-worded so they were accessible to children of all ages

Action to take as a result of Pupil Feedback on Computing from June 2022

- Liaise with staff for opportunities for children to use tablets more in class.
- Improve aspects of technology in school.
- KS1 Computing Club to raise the profile for younger children.

Action taken by subject leader since June 2022

- Tablets are readily available for Early years if they decide they want to use them. With the new suite being timetables Early years have opted to use this primarily.
- Bee Bots have not yet been introduced into provision but will be in Summer Term.
- Purple Mash was unable to be renewed just for Early Years. A new resource has been used for Early Years (2Simple and Early Years Program).

Why is learning how to use a computer important?

Can you describe what these things are and what they do?

Mouse – Children knew what it was and said it was for moving the black arrow around.

Keyboard – Children knew what it was and said it was used for writing names, passwords and numbers.

Monitor – Children called it a TV and needed to be prompted of what it was actually called.

Login – Children knew what this meant, 2 of the 4 children managed to show me how to login independently.

Children could also select an icon to choose a particular program.
