




The Local Area KS1 Knowledge Mat

street	A public road in a city, town, or village, typically with houses and buildings on one or both sides.		
road signs	Road sign gives you information, directions to places or warn you of possible dangers.		
office	A building where people work from. Some are large, tall buildings and others are very small.

post code	This locates exactly where a street or a place is by using letters and numbers.	<input type="checkbox"/> Your address has the name of the street you live in, the number or name of your house; the village, town or city you live in and a post code.	
urban	A busy locations which has lots of houses and usually shops and offices.	<input type="checkbox"/> London is the capital of England; Cardiff the capital of Wales, Edinburgh the capital of Scotland and Belfast the capital of Northern Ireland.	
rural	It is a location in the country. It is not usually as busy as an urban place.	<input type="checkbox"/> One of the oldest parliaments in the world is situated in London and is called the Houses of Parliament.
