Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 6:30pm in our school hall. We also have a second meeting planned for Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April, 6:30pm at The Gatehouse where we hope to plan further events for the summer term.



<u>Open afternoon and Stay and Play sessions</u> – Earlier this week, we held our open afternoon with headteacher forum at our Darlington Street site for Nursery, Reception and KS1 parents/carers. The next one of these will be on **Wednesday 13**<sup>th</sup> **March (1:30pm – 3:00pm)** and will be for **KS2 parents/carers only**. You are invited to spend the first part of the afternoon in your child's class and the second part of the afternoon you are welcomed into the

school hall or library to enjoy some refreshments where there is the opportunity to ask me questions about school life. It's quite an informal afternoon and provides you with the opportunity to gain an insight into life at our school.
