Dear parents/carers,

You will remember that our original aim was to have 'full' wraparound care provision in place at our school in June 2025. As we near the end of this month, it is highly likely that we will not fulfill this. You may have seen on the news how the Government are keen for all schools to have wraparound provision in place and so although registration was submitted the same day that 'Care, Love, Learn Childcare' were appointed, a back log of applications has meant that this has been delayed. As soon as registration is confirmed, we are looking to handover to 'Care, Love, Learn Childcare' to lead our provision – I will keep you updated.

Over the last month, we have continued to make progress where we can and we have worked with 'Care, Love, Learn Childcare' to confirm the hours the provision will operate, the prices for each session and we have also recruited staff to work within the provision.

The hours that 'Care, Love, Learn Childcare' will operate at St. George's Central CE Primary School and Nursery, for children in Nursery – Year 6, will be:

I can confirm that, like our current Breakfast Club, our school hall will act as a 'base' for the provision both before and after school. At times when the hall is in use, like we do now, the Year 3 classroom will be used. Therefore, your access to 'Care, Love, Learn Childcare' will be like it is currently for Breakfast Club.

We ask that you please avoid accessing our school car park both before school and at the end of the school day and make use of the school gates. If you are unsure of these access arrangements, then please do not hesitate to contact us in school.

There may be times when the children and staff are accessing other areas of school, for example: our playground, Forest School etc. At these times, 'Care, Love, Learn Childcare' will continue to use the current Breakfast Club door for all access and collection arrangements.
