




# A bit about me...



# ***Home Learning***

- Handed out on Mondays
- Spellings – particular pattern/ rule and 4 “non-negotiable” spellings.
- Reading- children will change their books once a week (handed in on a Friday and given back out the following Monday)
- SeeSaw – extra learning will be presented on our class’ SeeSaw page. You will receive more information about this throughout the year.

# ***Reading...***

- All children have received school reading book
- Expected home reading – at least 3 times per week
- Extra reading on Reading Plus (weekly targets to hit)
- Due to Covid-19, books will be changed once per week.
- Rewards given for consistent reading.



# ***Behaviour...***

- Rewarding positive behaviour.
- Time lost at play/ dinner as a sanction for poor behavioural choices/ lack of work.
- I am happy to discuss any outcomes with parents, both positive and negative.



# ***PE...***

- Indoor PE – Monday PM
- Outdoor PE – Tuesday PM
- Children need correct kit for each session.  
Indoor kits usually kept in school. Outdoor kits to be worn to school.
- \* During Autumn 2 (Nov/Dec) both sessions will be held on Tuesday due to MB Dance coaching the children!\*
