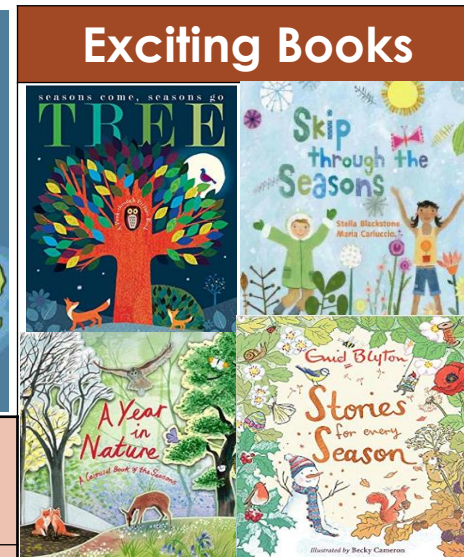


Why do leaves fall in autumn?

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
United Kingdom	The United Kingdom, made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, is an island nation in northwestern Europe.
country	Land that is controlled by a single government.
city	An inhabited place of greater size, population or importance than a town or village.
season	A time in the year (spring, summer, autumn and winter) marked by particular weather patterns and daylight hours.
weather	Weather is what the sky and the air outside are like, such as cold and cloudy.
weather forecast	What the weather is likely to be for the next day or few days.
temperature	The measured amount of heat in a place or in the body.
daytime	The time of day when the sky is light.
island	A piece of land completely surrounded by water.
sea	The salty water that covers a large part of the surface of the earth or a large area of salty water, smaller than an ocean, that is partly or completely surrounded by land.
ocean	A very large area of sea.



Sticky Knowledge about Weather and the UK
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There are four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter. The weather changes often in the United Kingdom. Different types of weather are more likely to happen in certain seasons.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The length of the day changes depending on the season.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The United Kingdom is made up of four countries: England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The United Kingdom is bordered by four seas: the English Channel, the North Sea, the Irish Sea and the Atlantic Ocean.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The UK is made up of several islands. The only land border connecting the UK to another country is between Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The capital city of the United Kingdom is London.
