La cabeza – head

La cara – face

Los ojos – eyes

La nariz – nose

¿Cómo se describe usted? (How do you describe yourself?)



Main questions and replies:

¿Cómo eres? – What do you look like?

¿Cómo es? – What does he/she look like?

Soy alta y delgada – I am tall and slim (female)

Soy joven y bajo – I am young and short (male)

Tengo los ojos verdes y el pelo rubio – I have green eyes and blonde hair.

Es alta y tiene los ojos azules – She is tall and has blue eyes.

Prior learning

Basic greetings, numbers 1 - 200, days/months, colours, pets, countries and nationalities, family members, likes and dislikes of food and sports.

Remember:

The adjective changes depending on whether the person being described is male or female. Adjectives describing males usually end in 'o' while adjectives describing females usually end in 'a'. When describing eye or hair colour, remember what the noun comes first followed by the adjective.
