Prior learning

Body parts, colours, numbers, ages, basic greetings.

¿Cuáles son los nombres de las diferentes prendas de ropa?

(What are the names of different items of clothing?)



Main questions and replies:

¿Qué ropa llevas? – What clothes are you wearing?

Llevo una camiseta amarilla y unos vaqueros azules. – I am wearing a yellow t-shirt and some blue jeans.

¿Dónde llevas tus guantes? – Where do you wear your shirt?

Llevo mis guantes en mis manos. – I wear my shirt on my body.

Remember:

We refer to some items of clothing as singular and some as plural, for example:

La camisa – Shirt (singular)

Los pantalones - Trousers (plural)

This changes many things when we are constructing sentences:

To say 'I am wearing a blue shirt' we would say:

Llevo una camisa azul.

To say 'I am wearing blue trousers,' we would say:

Llevo unos pantalones azules'.
