Rights	Is morally correct or honourable

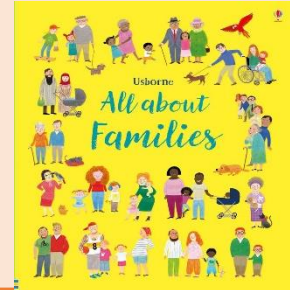
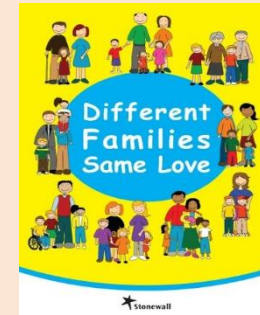
Who is special to us?
