<b>Strengths</b>	Actions that you do well.
<b>Internet</b>	The largest computer network to search for information and communicate with others.
<b>Digital device</b>	An electronic device that contains a computer. E.g. a tablet or smartphone.

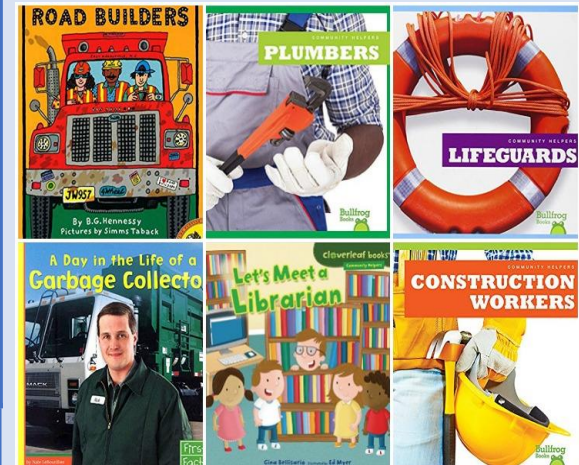
## What jobs do people do?
