## Key Vocabulary

<b>Tawhid</b>	Belief in one God as described in Islam.
<b>Iman</b>	The word for belief.
<b>Allah</b>	The Arabic word for God.
<b>Shahadah</b>	First pillar of Islam: There is no God but God and Muhammad is his prophet.
<b>Prophet Muhammad</b>	Messenger of God.
<b>PBUH</b>	Peace be upon him. Attached to the name of Muhammad by many Muslims.
<b>Qur'an</b>	Central religious text of Islam.
