Key Vocabulary	
Bible	The Christian scriptures, consisting of the Old and New Testament.
God	In Christian belief – the Creator and ruler of our universe.
Genesis	The time of when something came into existence and the first book of the Old Testament.
Creation	The act or process of bringing something into existence.
Gratitude	The quality of being thankful, showing appreciation and returning the act of kindness.
Prayer	An honest act of communication to God.

<p>Prior learning: Children will have learnt about God and why He is important to Christians.</p>
<p>Future Learning: Children will learn more about the Bible and stories that illustrate specific key concepts. Children will understand what Christians learn from the Creation story.</p>
