


# What is it like for someone to follow God?

Key Vocabulary	
<b>Covenant</b>	An agreement between God and His people, in which God makes promises to His people in return for something from them.
<b>Old Testament</b>	The first part of the Christian Bible, consisting of thirty-nine books, describing our world before the saviour Jesus Christ.
<b>New Testament</b>	The second part of the Christian Bible, recording the life and teachings of Christ and his earliest followers.
<b>People of God</b>	A person is initiated into God's people by a spiritual birth through faith in Christ and Baptism.
<b>Faith</b>	Complete trust or confidence in someone or something.
<b>Pact</b>	A formal agreement between individuals or parties.

<p><b>Prior learning:</b> Children will have learnt about who Christians believe made the world. Children will have learnt about what they believe God is like. Children will have learnt what it is like to belong to a faith.</p> <p><b>Future Learning:</b> Children will learn about why Christians follow God and what it means to be a Christian.</p>
