

What kind of King was Jesus?

Key Vocabulary	
Kingdom of God	Refers to God's reign on earth and consequently, in our hearts.
Jesus Christ	The man who Christians believe was the son of God, and whose teachings are the basis of Christianity.
King of Kings	In the Christian Church, a name or form of address for God and His Son, Jesus Christ.
Luke 4: 1-13	Jesus returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil.
Heaven	A place regarded in various religions as the abode of God (or gods) and the angels.
Justice	People are to be treated impartially, fairly and properly.
Christians	A person who has received Christian baptism or is a believer in Christianity.
