


What is the Good News Christians say Jesus brings?

Key Vocabulary	
Bible	The Christian scriptures, consisting of the Old and New Testaments.
Gospel	The teaching or revelation of Christ told through the four Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
Good News	For Christians, this good news includes being loved by God, and being forgiven for bad things.
Jesus Christ	The man who Christians believe was the son of God, and whose teachings are the basis of Christianity.
Big story	The Bible consists of four movements: Creation; Fall; Redemption; and New Creation.

<p>Prior learning: Children will have learnt about the stories which Jesus told.</p>
<p>Future Learning: Children will learn about what kind of world Jesus wanted Christians to live in. Children will learn about what kind of King Jesus was.</p>
