

What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?

Key Vocabulary

Islam	The religion of the Muslims, as revealed through Muhammad as the Prophet of Allah.
Prophet Muhammad PBUH	Founder of Islam and the proclaimer of the Qur'an, Islam's sacred scripture.
Holy Qur'an	Central religious text of Islam.
Allah	Arabic and Islamic name for God.
ibadah	An Arabic word meaning service or servitude. In Islam, ibadah is usually translated as "worship".
tawhid	In Islam, the oneness of Allah, in the sense that he is one and there is no God but he.
iman	Its most simple definition is the belief in the six articles of Islamic faith.
Sunnah	The Arabic term for the prophet Muhammad's way of life and legal precedent.
Hadith	A collection of traditions containing sayings of the prophet Muhammad with accounts of his daily practice.
