Key Vocabulary	
The Bible	The Christian scriptures, consisting of the Old and New Testament.
Gospels	The teaching of Christ through the books of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
Jesus Christ	The man who Christians believe was the son of God, and whose teachings are the basis of Christianity.
The Good News	For Christians, The Good News is being loved by God, and being forgiven for bad things.
The Good Samaritan	Someone acting selflessly to benefit others, even if a total stranger.
Parable	A simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson, told by Jesus in the Gospels.
Keith Hebden	Community Organiser and consultant, writer, activist, and priest. Keith fasted for forty days and forty nights to show his faith in Christianity.

<p>Prior learning: Children will have learnt about God making the world and what he intended Christians to do with it. Children will have learnt about the Good News that Christians believe Jesus brings.</p>
<p>Future Learning: Children will learn about why Christians believe Jesus is the Messiah. Children will learn about what kind of King Jesus was.</p>
