## Key Vocabulary

<b>God</b>	In Christianity the Creator of everything and source of authority.
<b>Creation</b>	The act of making something and all the things attributed to God.
<b>Genesis</b>	From the Hebrew meaning “beginning”, the first book of the Torah and Old Testament.
<b>pollution</b>	Things that are poisonous or harmful in our environment.
<b>world</b>	Our planet and all its countries and people.
<b>environment</b>	The surroundings in which we live.
<b>Psalms</b>	Sacred song used in Jewish or Christian worship found in the Book of Psalms
<b>hymns</b>	Religious songs
