<b>harvest</b>	The process of collecting crops or the time when this happens.
<b>Harvest Festival</b>	A celebration of the harvest held in Christian churches. It aims to support sustainable development and eradicate poverty.
<b>Christian Aid</b>	The official relief agency of more than 40 Christian churches in the UK
<b>Sukkot</b>	Jewish festival of the shelters. Celebrating God's care during their years in the wilderness.
<b>sukkah</b>	A temporary shelter constructed to use during the week of Sukkot
