| Subject Specific Vocabulary |   |

| clay                        | <b>Clay</b> is a naturally occurring sticky fine grained earth. It can be moulded into different shapes. <b>Clay</b> is used to make bricks, potteries, and ceramics. It is also used to make sculptures and decorative patterns and designs. |
| form                        | A solid shape has form, it is not flat.   |
| sculpture                   | An artistic object created in 3 dimensions.   |
| roll                        | Pressing down on a material to flatten it.  |
| knead                       | Pressing, folding, stretching.  |
| texture                     | How a surface feels to the touch.   |
