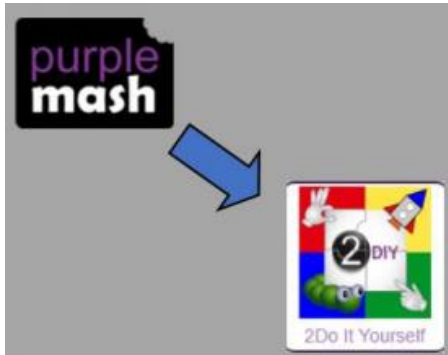
Sort
