To learn about onion skinning in animation.

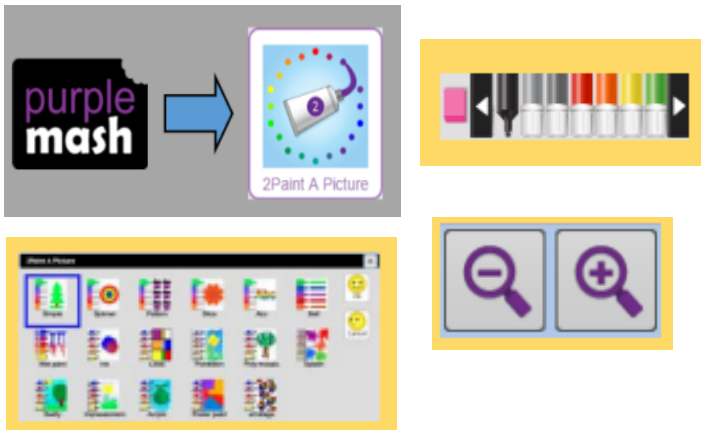
To add backgrounds and sounds to animations.

Vocabulary

Impressionism	The impressionist movement began in the 1860s and became most popular in the 1870s and 1880s. It differed from the common art of the time because it wasn't religious art, showing scenes from religious stories or specific events, but was just intended to capture a scene at a moment.
Palette	Within computer graphics, this is the range of colours or shapes available to the user.
Pointillism	Pointillism was a development of impressionism. It was invented mainly by George Seurat and Paul Signac. Pointillist paintings are created by using small dots in different colours to build up the whole picture.
Share	An instance of posting or reposting something on a social media website or application.
Surrealism	Explored the subconscious areas of the mind. The artwork often made little sense as it was usually trying to depict a dream or random thoughts.
Template	Something that serves as a model for others to copy.

Fun Facts:

- Impressionism is a style of painting that focuses on the effects of light and atmosphere on colours and forms. Impressionist artists often used broken brush strokes.
- Pointillism is a painting technique developed by the artist George Seurat. It involves using small, painted dots to create areas of colour that together form a pattern or picture.
- Surrealistic art is characterised by dream-like visuals, the use of symbolism and collage images. Several prominent artists came from this movement, including Renee Magritte, Salvador Dali, and Max Ernst.
- There are many different apps that can create different art styles. Its like creating art as your favourite artist.
