

## Y1/2 - How can pictures represent data?




Tally charts are used to present data and information. Each tally represents one piece of data. This makes it easy to collect data as you go along.

Computers help us to lay out the data so it is evenly spaced, and easy to read and understand. Computers make it easy for us to enter the data.

With the click of a button, we can add another piece of data to the <u>pictogram</u>.



One line = One piece of data

Five lines are shown with four lines and a diagonal line across them. This makes it easier to count up later!

Some charts also include a key or a table to clearly show your data.


Y axis

Pictograms show data through pictures. Each picture is one piece of data.



Block charts present data and information. Sometimes each block will represent more than one piece of data. The Y axis helps you to see how much data is in each category.
