Dear parents/carers,

We have been able to accommodate **all** 'key/critical worker' requests and so, if you have made a request to school for your child to attend from tomorrow, we will expect to see them in the morning at **8:45am**. Please note, if your child is in school, they are to attend 'their usual hours'. For example: a nursery child will attend for their agreed hours and children in Reception – Year 6 are expected to attend each day.

Please see below, our school arrangements in light of school closing for 'face to face' teaching for most children:

***IF YOUR CHILD IS IN SCHOOL/NURSERY**

Your children will be organised in key phase 'bubbles' throughout this lockdown period:

- Lancaster Avenue Nursery children-
- Darlington Street Nursery children-
- All Reception children-
- Year 1 and Year 2 children-
- Year 3 and Year 4 children-
- Year 5 and Year 6 children-

There will be no Breakfast Club during this lockdown period

We will open our classroom doors to **all** children at both our sites at **8:45am**.

All children are to wear their school uniform as usual.

Please continue to follow the now established one-way system when entering and leaving our school site.

Children will enter school via the following classroom doors:

Lancaster Avenue Nursery children will enter and leave nursery through their normal nursery door

Darlington Street Nursery children will enter and leave school through nursery

Reception children will enter and leave through **Reception:TK** classroom at the rear of school

Year 1 children will enter and leave through **Y1TL** classroom, at the rear of school

Year 2 children will enter and leave through **Y2JW** classroom, at the front of school

Year 3 children will enter and leave through **Y3LK** classroom, near the school car park

Year 4 children will enter and leave through **Y4HJ** classroom, 'Peel Hall' side of school

Year 5 children will enter and leave through **Y5JY** classroom, at the rear of school

Year 6 children will enter and leave through **Y6AJM** classroom, at the rear of school

Lunchtime arrangements will be as normal (packed lunches and school dinners as appropriate).

Children are to come to school in their outdoor PE kits on the following days:

Year 1 children: Tuesday

Year 2 children: Wednesday

Year 3 children: Tuesday

Year 4 children: Wednesday

Year 5 children: Thursday

Year 6 children: Friday

We will open our classroom doors to **all** children for collection at both our sites from **3:00pm**.

IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT IN SCHOOL, THEY SHOULD
