IF YOUR CHILD IS IN SCHOOL/NURSERY Only children from St. George's Central CE Primary School and Nursery will be present at our sites. School/Nursery will be open at the usual times. All children are to wear their school uniform as usual. Breakfast Club will be open from 7:30am as usual (if you specifically need this, it would be good if you could email school so we have some idea of the number of children). There will be no after school clubs during these weeks. Lunchtime arrangements will be as normal (packed lunches and school dinners as appropriate).
