We are all having to 'flourish' as 'adaptable individuals', as our School Vision states and I thank you all again for your support during this last month.





<u>School photographs</u> – You will know from the email earlier this week that we will receive our first visit of the year from the school photographer on **Monday 5**th **October**. On this day he will visit both our Darlington Street School site for the morning and our Lancaster Avenue Nursery site for the afternoon. This year:

- *all photographs will be taken of children individually (no sibling photographs);
- *only children who attend St. George's Central CE Primary School and Nursery will be photographed;
- *any Darlington Street Nursery children who do not usually attend Nursery on a Monday morning are invited to attend the Monday morning session at no extra cost (see Mrs Davies to confirm attendance);
- *any Lancaster Avenue Nursery children who do not usually attend Nursery on a Monday afternoon are invited to attend the Monday afternoon session at no extra cost (see Ms Naughton to confirm attendance).



All children will have their photograph taken and a small 'sample' photograph will be sent home for you to decide if you would like to complete any purchases.

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<u>Bikeability sessions</u> – Some Year 6 children will be taking part in 'Bikeability' sessions next week. The children will be learning how to cycle safely on the road including signalling, positioning and how to complete safety checks on their bikes *A reminder for all that when bikes and scooters are brought onto our school site they are pushed and not ridden so as to reduce the risk of accidents.*

<u>Harvest Celebrations</u> – At this time of year in school we would normally be asking for your donations and inviting you to join us in school and at St. George's Church for our Harvest Celebrations. Unfortunately, with the current restrictions in place, we will be marking this celebration in a different way this year. Some of our older pupils will be inviting us to give thanks for the harvest we have enjoyed from the planting in our



school grounds over recent months, while our very youngest children will record songs about creation they have been learning. All the other classes have explored the creation ABC poem, 'The Blue and Green Ark' by Brian Patten and will use our new recording studio in school to film a contribution from each class that will form a virtual service for us to share, during October.



<u>Phone call home</u> – Up until last week, we were still planning to invite you into school to safely meet 'face to face' with your child's teacher for Parents' Evening. Unfortunately, the new restrictions brought into force meant that we had to have a re-think and advice from Wigan Council was that we look at alternative ways of undertaking Parents' Evening at this time. Therefore, our approach will be that you will **receive a phone call home from your child's teacher on a given day, at a given time**. If your child attends our Lancaster Avenue

Nursery, Darlington Street Nursery or is in Reception, then you will receive an email about this on Monday. All other year groups will receive emails over the next few weeks. Please note, because of this approach, some of the originally planned dates have changed:
